City of Madera General Plan Update Public Advisory Committee Convenes to Initiate General Plan Update Public Input Process

MADERA, CA—The City of Madera General Plan Update Public Advisory Committee will be meeting Monday, November 26 to initiate efforts to engage the public in the City's General Plan Update (GPU) process. The Public Advisory Committee will be reviewing and discussing the GPU process and planning outreach meetings at which the community will be able to assist in shaping the future of Madera.

The City staff is excited that the General Plan Update is underway and that many of the public volunteers from the community's Vision 2025 planning efforts will be assisting and advising us in the update of the City's General Plan.

The Madera General Plan will be a "blueprint" for future development that represents the community's vision of Madera's future. The GPU will include the following components, called elements: land use, circulation, housing, conservation, open-space, noise, safety, community character, community design and sustainability.

Over the next two years, the City will be holding a series of public meetings and workshops in various locations throughout the City to involve as much of the community as possible in this crucial planning process. Meetings will include information in Spanish as well as in English.
